Teams Edgar/Shedden and Meader/Zorget both struck off well for the final game, with Edgar running the first hoop to take an early lead. Meader responded strongly by swiftly taking the next two hoops leaving Edgar to steal hoop four. Meader then ran hoop five before expertly scoring hoop six from 15 feet to win the game 4-2.
